



SCHOOL UNIFORM - GENERAL

To enable consistency in colours and branding, we will be using Schooltogs as our school uniform sole supplier. Purchase uniform direct from Schooltogs, who offer an online service with free delivery/collection to the school during term time www.schooltogs.com/st-wystans-school-derby. To ensure the correct size skirt can be ordered, there will be a range of sizes held at school, so that pupils can try them on. Items marked with * are available from the school office. Swimwear from Speedo direct.

The piercing of ears is not permitted during school term time. Girls whose ears are already pierced must wear only plain studs. These must be removed during sporting activities. The school cannot accept any responsibility for injury caused due to the wearing of any earring or stud. Girls who have long hair must have it tied back. Scrunchies or hair bands must be navy, or royal blue. Pupils are expected to come to school and return home in full school uniform Pupils should make every effort to look smart.
