



## PRINCIPLES FOR PARENT

### WHAT WE NEED YOU TO DO IF YOUR CHILD IS COMING BACK TO SCHOOL

1. Do not send your child into school if they (or anyone in your household) is showing symptoms of Covid 19.
2. Check your child's temperature before leaving the house for school. Do not bring them to school if they have an elevated temperature of 37.8 degC or higher.
3. If possible walk to school. If you have to come by car, park further away and walk (so 2m distancing can be maintained).
4. Do not be late when dropping your child/children off and picking them up (to avoid mixing with the next group arriving).
5. For drop off and pick up we will operate a one-way system through the school grounds maintaining 2m distancing. Please enter the school via Brookside Close and join the 2m queuing system to drop off or collect you child/children.
6. Do not let your child/children mix with other people at the start/end of the day.
7. If you normally bring your child to school, only 1 parent will be able to do this.
8. Sorry but you will not be allowed to bring your child in to the school building. A member of staff will meet you at the main school entrance to carry out the temperature test on your child / children.
9. You will need to move away immediately after handing your child/children over and getting the 'thumbs up' for the temperature test (no standing and waiting).
10. Do not stand and chat to people by the school gate or near the school building.
11. If your child wears a face mask walking to school and cannot take it off by themselves, then you need to do this quickly before handing them over.
12. If your child is able to remove their own mask, they need to bring a plastic bag to put it in when they get inside, until home time.
13. Your child/children will only be allowed to bring their own snack, drinks and lunch from home.
14. Do not expect any staff to take verbal messages. Any messages you need to pass on should be emailed to the class teacher. This will be regularly checked, however please do not expect and immediate response as the teacher will be with the pupils.
15. Teachers will email you if they need to communicate with you.
16. Any absence or sickness should be communicated by the school App.
17. Latecomers should, in the first instance, try to enter via the Brookside Close entrance and join the 2m queuing system. If the gate is locked, please drop off via the front gate, ensuring that all parents exiting via the one-way system have cleared the school grounds, maintaining 2m distancing.
18. Collection of children during the school day should only be carried out if with prior agreement of the Headteacher.
19. Ensure your child / children come to school in freshly laundered PE kit or school uniform. Leave blazers and hats at home please.
20. Share the new pupil rules with your child.
